***Reporte del Director***

  - NWEA: Preliminary results are suggesting good growth. This test helps predict CAASP test scores coming up in April.
    - Ms.Esrey: results in her class from two weeks ago show that 50% of her class are already meeting Spring goals. Students were aware of their score and had growth goals.
    - Next meeting will Mr.Cuevas will have the final NWEA results to show parents. Research shows when scores are higher, students have higher attendance, less suspension, etc.
